

2012 AUSTRALIAN SUPERCROSS CHAMPIONSHIPS

Final Instructions

1 Truck Parking

Truck park - Please see schedule

2 Sign-On

Sign on, please see schedule (which includes pit board area sign in and VIP viewing platform area)

Wrist bands will be handed out at sign in and must be worn to gain access to pit area.

3 Riders Briefing

Riders briefing, please see schedule.

It is compulsory to attend riders briefing any rider not in attendance will be fined

4 Phillip Island Credentials

Phillip Island credentials will be sent shortly. All riders/mechanics must have the correct passes on them when entering the Phillip Island venue. All vehicles must have passes on them to gain entry. Please observe the strict park up schedule. Cars/Trucks will not be able to leave the venue until after 7.30pm each night, however there is a car park available outside the venue (at cost).

5 Motorcycling Washing

Motorcycles can only be washed in designated wash bays – no exceptions.

6 Scrutineering

Self scrutineering sheets must be filled in and handed in at sign in – forms can be downloaded from the SX website

7 Medical

Medical forms must be filled out forwarded to the race secretary – forms can be downloaded from the SX website
www.australiansupercross.com.au

8 Pits

The pits will be open to the public from 3pm-6pm at Dubbo, Toowoomba and Newcastle and all day at Phillips Island, please ensure all valuables are safely locked away.

Factory riders are expected to be present for rider autograph signings during this time.

At Dubbo, Toowoomba and Newcastle at 6pm the pits will be cleared.

Pit tents must be secured properly – sandbags may be needed in high wind areas ie Phillip Island round.

Fuel must be in appropriate containers.

9 Bump-In

Safety harnesses must be worn when erecting truck awnings off the ground.

10 Power Leads

All Power leads must be tagged. Failure to meet the OHS standards may result in fines from Worksafe.

IEG take no responsibility for competitors and teams who do not meet the Australian Standards and Occupational Health and Safety Act

11 Dress Code

A strict dress code will apply to all mechanic's planning on going into the mechanic's area – Mechanic's will need a collared shirt and pit board.

12 Pit Board Area

Pit board area is TBA.

Only mechanic's with pit boards and correct wrist bands will be allowed in the pit board area.

All mechanics in the pit boarding area will have to sign an indemnity at sign in

13 Race Schedule

The race schedule is posted on www.australiansupercross.com.au

14 Race Numbers

Please make sure your numbers are legible including your corresponding back numbers.

Riders without back numbers will not be able to start

15 Decals

The series designed art work must be on the top of all front number plates. Artwork is available from the SX web site <http://www.australiansupercross.com.au/>

16 Timing Transmitter

It is the riders responsibility to ensure transponders are fitted to their machine and that they are returned when racing has concluded. If not returned rider will be invoiced for the transponder.

17 Timing Results

Results will be available to access that will be announced soon.

18 Pre-Start & Start Area

Only the rider and mechanic in the pre start area

Riders must be in the pre start area prior to their race (schedule will be posted on line prior to event). Any rider not in the pre start by this time will receive last gate pick.

Only the rider and the mechanic will be allowed onto the start area, no rider will be allowed to prepare in front of the gate, no tools may be used behind the gate.

19 Presentations

It is compulsory for any rider who finishes on the podium to attend presentation.

20 Helmet Cams

The use of helmet cams must be approved by IEG.

21 Control Tyre

Junior Lites and 85cc & 150cc 4 stroke BW class will be conducted on controlled tyres (Pirelli). It's the riders' responsibility to have the tyres fitted.

22 Passes

There will be no additional pit passes. Any additional people wishing to attend must purchase general admission tickets which can be purchased from <http://www.ticketdirect.com.au/Event/Season/875> for Dubbo, Toowoomba and Newcastle. For Phillip Island round tickets can be purchased through the GP Corp. at <http://www.motogp.com.au/tickets>

23 Camping

There is no camping at any of the venues, however at Phillip Island there is a camping ground close please go to the Moto GP website for details <http://www.motogp.com.au>

24 ATVs

ATVs will be permitted – helmets must be worn at all times and they must be driven at walking pace. (with the exception of Phillip Island)

25 Glass

No glass containers to be brought into any venue
