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ASBK Trade Alley is a FREE opportunity for vendors to setup a space to demo and sell products on Saturday and Sunday. We encourage both motorcycle related and non-motorcycle related vendors to apply, as we attract a wide variety of spectators.

Each vendor must provide a list of employees working and will be allocated passes based on the roster. Any extra required passes must be advised to Motorcycling Australia approximately ten (10) days prior to the event commencing. Vehicle access passes will be issued to assist vendors in servicing their sites outside of event hours and park in the outside carparks. Please note there is strictly no parking in the display area and bump in/out times must be followed.

Please note if bringing a tent, it will need to be weighted or pegged down. Power is not provided, but can be arranged. If you require power, please indicate so on your application. Vendors may incur charges for power. Gates to the circuit are locked at night and security is on site, however Motorcycling Australia does not take responsibility for any goods left overnight.

All vendors must provide Motorcycling Australia with relevant insurance documentation/cover notes stating at a minimum, that the vendor is in fact insured for greater than ten million dollars in respect of public liability insurance that is applicable to their business. Once received, MA will forward this to our insurer for assessment.

Your completed application will be assessed upon receipt. If accepted, you will receive a confirmation via email. Further details regarding site allocation, bump in/out times, gate entry, and an on-site contact will be sent in the lead up to the event.

It is important that all related sponsors are listed. Direct sponsorship conflicts with ASBK Sponsors will be requested to be covered or taken down.
