








MORGAN PARK CIRCUIT MAP

GETTING STARTED: RACING Words: Jeff Ware

OUT OF PIT LANE

As you sit here and wish you could be out there on the track, don't forget that getting started in motorcycle racing isn't as hard as you think.

Chances are you already own a bike that can be raced. These days there are classes for just about anything with two wheels, regardless of age or performance level.

The most important step is to get started and get involved!

Motorcycling Australia's (MA) is the sanctioning body for all motorcycle racing in Australia. All National Licences are handled by each State's or Territories respective State Controlling Body (SCB). Step one is contacting your relevant SCB and the joining a motorcycle club in your local area. Next, you obtain a Junior (7-U16 years) or Senior (16 years and over) National Licence, which is managed through your SCB.

Further information can be found via the MA website, www. ma.org.au/getting-started.

Don't be afraid to check out numerous clubs in your local area before joining one. Each club is unique and finding the one that suits you best will make the transition to road racing that bit easier!



GETTING LICENCED

Each club and your SCB will be more than happy to guide you through the licencing process. Depending on your age, will dictate which national licence you obtain.

For further information, contact your club or your SCB.

PROTECTION

While we don't like talking about it, people do fall off motorbikes on racetracks. MA requires all licence holders to have their own personal Ambulance subscription. We'd recommend that you have your own income protection and that it includes coverage for motorcycle racing. No one wants to use up all of their sickies and holidays recovering from an accident.



Protection also includes your own riding gear. Starting from the top, you require a full-face helmet that is approved to AS1698, which is the Australian Standard for helmets for street use anyway. Alternatively, MA also recognises international standards so if your helmet does not have AS1698 you can check with MA that it is ok to use.

A set of one-piece leathers that fit is the preferred way to cover the larger parts of your anatomy. Make sure they're roomy enough for you to wear the mandatory back protector underneath, and a chest protector is recommended too.

The best leather gloves you can afford will keep your digits intact if you're sliding down the track and using your hands

There's a huge variety of suitable boots on display at any decent-sized motorcycle shop. Take the time to find a pair that fit properly without being too tight. Tight boots will ruin your day very quickly.

GETTING YOUR BIKE READY

If you're not overly mechanically minded, don't worry, your local bike shop should be able to check your bike over before you venture on track for the first time. A full service and tune-up now could save you from a big bill later. All racing classes have common rules to ensure bikes don't fall apart or leak fluid on the track. Before you're allowed on track at any race meeting, your bike will be inspected by a scrutineer. Don't give them a hard time if they pull you up and point out something you've forgotten.

The majority of them have been doing this for a long time and don't want to see anybody get hurt due to an oversight. Full rules for your class are in the Manual of Motorcycle Sport available at www.ma.org.au. But keep in mind that bike preparation is very important and quite in-depth for racing. Like you, your bike needs controlled fluid retention.

TIPS FOR KEEPING COMFORTABLE

Assuming you're like the rest of us, you'll be carting yourself and your bike to the track in a trailer, ute or van. There are a few things we'd advise you chuck in. These may sound obvious but people still forget.

Grab an esky and fill it with ice bricks and bottles of cold water. You'll be amazed at just how easy it is to dehydrate while racing on a hot day.

Even though racetrack food has improved from the days of dodgy hamburgers and warm soft drinks, chuck snack-type things in the esky along with sandwiches. You'll burn off a lot of calories in a day and replacing them with racetrack food could send you broke.

Not all racetracks offer covered pit areas so some sort of shade device will make your day much more enjoyable. Don't forget the sunscreen either.

The most important thing to take with you is a sense of humour. On its own this could be the difference between a day best forgotten and one of the best experiences of your life.

If you think you can't afford to race think again. It costs the same to race as it does to maintain a road bike or a track day bike, and entry fees for club racing are around that of a ride day – but you get a lot more laps at many race meetings...

GET YOUR GEAR ON

You need the best you can afford and then some more. Spend more on your gear than your bike if you have to but, like is the case with your bike, having shiny new parts is a waste if you are learning. You will inevitably test your riding gear. A lot. So go for an affordable compromise. Don't buy the most expensive graphics on your lid if a plain white one is going to be cheaper, for example. But don't skimp on quality...

YMF R3 CUP & BLU CRU OCEANIA JUNIOR CUP

Two Championships that are a great starting point for younger and beginner racers is the Yamaha Motor Finance (YMF) R3 Cup and the bLU cRU Oceania Junior Cup.



The YMF R3 cup is a spec-racing series for riders commencing their national road racing journey. All the YMF R3 Cup riders use the same bike model, the Yamaha YZF-R3, which produces an even playing field that fosters and encourages new riding talent. The race-ready R3 Cup bike is a great way to get started and is also eligible to race in the YMI Supersport 300 category when the rider is ready.

The bLU cRU Oceania Junior Cup, a new Junior Road Race Academy for competitors aged 11 to under 16 years, is another fantastic avenue through which aspiring junior riders can commence their racing career.

For the single price of \$7,750 AUD (2019 price and excluding travel and accommodation), juniors can apply to join the ground-breaking program which can set them on a path on a Road to MotoGPTM. Every rider in the bLU cRU Oceania Junior Cup is equipped with a Yamaha YZF-R15, delivering a dependable and reliable ride on an even playing field.

Providing an invaluable experience in pursuing a career in Road Racing, the bLU cRU Oceania Junior Cup is an immensely important step in the right direction as Australian juniors embark on their road to success!

THE BIKE

You'll need to spend a bit of time here – all fluid retaining fasteners need to be lockwired, fairings need catch areas in the bellypan, you need a tether kill switch, brake callipers bolts need to be lockwired and you need good suspension, brakes and bodywork. You also need a bullet-proof engine because you are going to thrash it beyond any ride day or road level of thrash!

ROUND 3 SUPERBIKE REVIEW

GET UP TO SPEED WITH ALL THE ACTION FROM ROUND 3 OF THE ASBK

Bryan Staring (Kawasaki BCperformance, Kawasaki ZX10RR) has lept into the lead of the 2019 Motul Pirelli Australian Superbike Championship (ASBK) with a clean-sweep of all three races at The Bend Motorsport Park for Round 3 during International MotoFest, alongside Round 2 of the Asia Road Racing Championship (ARRC). Staring had the edge over his opponents in managing tyre wear on the grippy Bend Motorsport Park surface, showing fantastic pace late in all three races to pick up the full 75 championship points. His win in Race 1 of the Asia Road Racing Championship for Kawasaki Thailand Racing Team means that Staring claimed four races from a possible five across the two series, in a brilliant weekend for the West Australian.

RACE 1

As the lights went out Maxwell snuck up the inside of Off the start Arthur Sissis (SA Demolition, Suzuki GSX-R) got a superb launch to lead them into turn one ahead of Daniel Falzon (Yamaha Racing Team, Yamaha YZF-R1) and Mike Jones (Desmosport Ducati, Ducati Panagale FE). A massive crash at turn three saw Team Suzuki ECSTAR Australia rider Alex Phillis (Suzuki GSX-R) brought down in a tangle with another rider, and the resultant low-side sending him into the side of Glenn Allerton (NextGen Motorsports, BMW S100RR). Phillis escaped without injury, but Allerton was in visible discomfort and was later taken to hospital after the race was red flagged.



The race was subsequently trimmed to nine laps and it was Falzon who led Jones off the restart and through turn one. Mark Chiodo (Penrite Honda Racing, Honda CBR1000SP) got a superb start to work his way up to second, then passed Falzon before the lap was finished, powering on to the lead. Falzon briefly took the lead back before running wide and dropping to third. By the time the field crossed the line again it was Chiodo ahead of Jones, Falzon, Staring, Wayne Maxwell (Team Suzuki ECSTAR Australia, Suzuki GSX-R) and Cru Holliday (Yamaha Racing Team, Yamaha YZF-R1).

As the field settled down Chiodo looked to set a quick pace early, and only Jones was capable of going with him at the front with the rest of the field dropping a few seconds back. Maxwell crashed out of the race on lap three trying to take Falzon around the outside at turn one, and by half distance Jones was looking for a way past Chiodo as the Honda rider's rear tyre started to lose its efficacy. Staring was continuing his good form from the Asia Road Racing Championship, holding third ahead of Cru Halliday and Josh Waters (Team Suzuki ECSTAR Australia, Suzuki GSX-R).

The leading Chiodo and Jones were slowly starting to fall back into the clutches of the pursing Staring and Halliday. Jones ran wide trying to take the lead off Chiodo at turn one on lap six, letting Chiodo back through and Staring seized his opportunity to go into second place. Staring set his sights on Chiodo and the Penrite Honda man made the CBR as wide as possible, before finally relenting when Staring made an easy pass for the lead on lap six. Staring was never headed from there, taking the chequered flag ahead of Jones and a fast-closing Cru Halliday, then Chiodo, Falzon, Waters and Glenn Scott (GSR Kawasaki, Kawasaki ZX-10R).



Visible in their support of Staring on the podium were team members from Kawasaki Thailand Racing Team, for whom Staring had ridden to victory in Race 1 of the ARRC earlier in the day.

"One of the things I enjoy the most about racing is when I see the people around me very happy" Staring said of his new teammates. "I love having their support and I love being able to contribute to putting the smile on their faces."

RACE 2

As the field got away Sissis again catapulted his way into second place from 11th on the grid behind Maxwell and Falzon completing the front group. Phillis also had a great aetaway from thirteenth and made it to third.

GET UP TO SPEED WITH ALL THE ACTION FROM ROUND 3 OF THE ASBK

Maxwell looked to build up a lead early ahead of Halliday with Staring then working his way to the front of the chasing pack. Over the line for the first time was Maxwell from Halliday, Staring, Phillis, Falzon and Waters.

On lap three Staring lost out to Falzon when he backed it into turn one and ran wide, letting Falzon through into third. Lap four and the top nine riders started to reconvene at the front with Maxwell and Halliday, getting reeled in by the chasing Falzon and Starina, with Waters and Phillis behind.

Staring had caught Halliday and Maxwell by lap five and was starting to have a few gentle looks up the inside of Halliday. Halliday looked to his left along the main straight to try and spot Staring behind him, who slid to Halliday's right side and snuck past almost completely unnoticed. Halfway round the lap, Staring past Maxwell as well and had already built up a second's worth of lead by the time they crossed the start/finish again.

Further down the pack, Jones began joining the leaders, taking Maxwell down the inside into turn 10 to slide into second, commencing his pursuit of Staring. Staring held the lead to the finish, ahead of Jones, Maxwell, Halliday, Waters, and Troy Herfoss (Penrite Honda Racing, Honda CBR RR SP)

RACE 3

Maxwell got a cracking start to get the holeshot into turn one but as the field came through turn two, Falzon crashed off the circuit into a cloud of dust, marking a sad end to a promising weekend. Jones forced his way past Maxwell at tum 10 which caused Maxwell to have to stand the bike up and give Jones first place. Over the line it was Jones, Maxwell, Phillis, Chiodo, and Waters, with Halliday in sixth.


Lap three and Maxwell was looking for a way past Jones at the front, as the two tried to create a gap between themselves and Mark Chiodo who was having another superb run early in third. Maxwell was setting fastest laps in pursuit of the Panigale, finally making it past into turn one on lap four. Weekend hero Staring remained down in sixth behind Waters and Halliday, with Chiodo looking for a way into second past Jones. Chiodo backed it into turn 17 a little too hard, and in the end made a good effort to gather it all up before he hit Jones to run off into the relative safety of the grass. He resumed behind Alex Phillis down in ninth.

Five laps to go and Staring was hitting his straps, passing Jones on the outside of turn 10 and steaming past Waters for second place. Staring was setting 1:53s to his opponents' 1:54's, and with four to go Staring capitalised on a Maxwell mistake on the exit of the last corner to lead the race.

Staring's opponents fought amongst themselves for second place, with defending ASBK champ Herfoss looking particularly good late in the race as he tried to force Halliday off the podium and claim third spot. He had a go up the inside into turn six but went in too hot and let Halliday back through when he ran wide. Bryan Staring cruised over the line to take his fourth victory in two classes for the weekend, with Maxwell, Halliday, Herfoss, Jones and Waters behind.

"Four from five!" exclaimed Staring on the podium. "Broc (Parkes) got the better of me in one of the ARRC races earlier today, but I'm so happy for how my weekend went."
