In addition to the ongoing technical checks carried out throughout the Championship, further technical inspections were conducted on the following Supersport 300 and Supersport 600 machines after the final race of both classes at Morgan Park Raceway:

Engine seals were inspected prior to disassembly and were found to be intact and functional.

The following technical inspections was conducted on the machines listed above:

- Camshaft profiles; All units were found to be compliant
- Valve Diameters: All units were found to be compliant
- Throttle Body Size All units were found to be compliant
- Engine Capacity All units were found to be compliant
- Gasket thickness All units were found to be compliant (where applicable)
