








WINTON MOTOR RACEWAY CURCUIT MAP

GETTING STARTED: RACING Words: Jeff Ware

OUT OF PIT LANE

As you sit here and wish you could be out there on the track, don't forget that getting started in motorcycle racing isn't as hard as you think.

Chances are you already own a bike that can be raced. These days there are classes for just about anything with two wheels, regardless of age or performance level.

The most important step is to get started and get involved!

Motorcycling Australia's (MA) is the sanctioning body for all motorcycle racing in Australia. All National Licences are handled by each State's or Territories respective State Controlling Body (SCB). Step one is contacting your relevant SCB and the joining a motorcycle club in your local area. Next, you obtain a Junior (7-U16 years) or Senior (16 years and over) National Licence, which is managed through your SCB.

Further information can be found via the MA website, www. ma.org.au/getting-started.

Don't be afraid to check out numerous clubs in your local area before joining one. Each club is unique and finding the one that suits you best will make the transition to road racing that bit easier!



GETTING LICENCED

Each club and your SCB will be more than happy to guide you through the licencing process. Depending on your age, will dictate which national licence you obtain.

For further information, contact your club or your SCB.

PROTECTION

While we don't like talking about it, people do fall off motorbikes on racetracks. MA requires all licence holders to have their own personal Ambulance subscription. We'd recommend that you have your own income protection and that it includes coverage for motorcycle racing. No one wants to use up all of their sickies and holidays recovering from an accident.



Protection also includes your own riding gear. Starting from the top, you require a full-face helmet that is approved to AS1698, which is the Australian Standard for helmets for street use anyway. Alternatively, MA also recognises international standards so if your helmet does not have AS1698 you can check with MA that it is ok to use.

A set of one-piece leathers that fit is the preferred way to cover the larger parts of your anatomy. Make sure they're roomy enough for you to wear the mandatory back protector underneath, and a chest protector is recommended too.

The best leather gloves you can afford will keep your digits intact if you're sliding down the track and using your hands

There's a huge variety of suitable boots on display at any decent-sized motorcycle shop. Take the time to find a pair that fit properly without being too tight. Tight boots will ruin your day very quickly.

GETTING YOUR BIKE READY

If you're not overly mechanically minded, don't worry, your local bike shop should be able to check your bike over before you venture on track for the first time. A full service and tune-up now could save you from a big bill later. All racing classes have common rules to ensure bikes don't fall apart or leak fluid on the track. Before you're allowed on track at any race meeting, your bike will be inspected by a scrutineer. Don't give them a hard time if they pull you up and point out something you've forgotten.

The majority of them have been doing this for a long time and don't want to see anybody get hurt due to an oversight. Full rules for your class are in the Manual of Motorcycle Sport available at www.ma.org.au. But keep in mind that bike preparation is very important and quite in-depth for racing. Like you, your bike needs controlled fluid retention.

TIPS FOR KEEPING COMFORTABLE

Assuming you're like the rest of us, you'll be carting yourself and your bike to the track in a trailer, ute or van. There are a few things we'd advise you chuck in. These may sound obvious but people still forget.

Grab an esky and fill it with ice bricks and bottles of cold water. You'll be amazed at just how easy it is to dehydrate while racing on a hot day.

Even though racetrack food has improved from the days of dodgy hamburgers and warm soft drinks, chuck snack-type things in the esky along with sandwiches. You'll burn off a lot of calories in a day and replacing them with racetrack food could send you broke.

Not all racetracks offer covered pit areas so some sort of shade device will make your day much more enjoyable. Don't forget the sunscreen either.

The most important thing to take with you is a sense of humour. On its own this could be the difference between a day best forgotten and one of the best experiences of your life.

If you think you can't afford to race think again. It costs the same to race as it does to maintain a road bike or a track day bike, and entry fees for club racing are around that of a ride day – but you get a lot more laps at many race meetings...

GET YOUR GEAR ON

You need the best you can afford and then some more. Spend more on your gear than your bike if you have to but, like is the case with your bike, having shiny new parts is a waste if you are learning. You will inevitably test your riding gear. A lot. So go for an affordable compromise. Don't buy the most expensive graphics on your lid if a plain white one is going to be cheaper, for example. But don't skimp on quality...

YMF R3 CUP & BLU CRU OCEANIA JUNIOR CUP

Two Championships that are a great starting point for younger and beginner racers is the Yamaha Motor Finance (YMF) R3 Cup and the bLU cRU Oceania Junior Cup.



The YMF R3 cup is a spec-racing series for riders commencing their national road racing journey. All the YMF R3 Cup riders use the same bike model, the Yamaha YZF-R3, which produces an even playing field that fosters and encourages new riding talent. The race-ready R3 Cup bike is a great way to get started and is also eligible to race in the YMI Supersport 300 category when the rider is ready.

The bLU cRU Oceania Junior Cup, a new Junior Road Race Academy for competitors aged 11 to under 16 years, is another fantastic avenue through which aspiring junior riders can commence their racing career.

For the single price of \$7,750 AUD (2019 price and excluding travel and accommodation), juniors can apply to join the ground-breaking program which can set them on a path on a Road to MotoGPTM. Every rider in the bLU cRU Oceania Junior Cup is equipped with a Yamaha YZF-R15, delivering a dependable and reliable ride on an even playing field.

Providing an invaluable experience in pursuing a career in Road Racing, the bLU cRU Oceania Junior Cup is an immensely important step in the right direction as Australian juniors embark on their road to success!

THE BIKE

You'll need to spend a bit of time here – all fluid retaining fasteners need to be lockwired, fairings need catch areas in the bellypan, you need a tether kill switch, brake callipers bolts need to be lockwired and you need good suspension, brakes and bodywork. You also need a bullet-proof engine because you are going to thrash it beyond any ride day or road level of thrash!

EXPERIENCE THE RIDE OF A LIFETIME

Ever wondered what it would be like to jump on a Superbike and have a go?

ROUND 4 SUPERBIKE REVIEW

GET UP TO SPEED WITH ALL THE ACTION FROM ROUND 4 OF THE ASBK

Wayne Maxwell (Team Suzuki ECSTAR Australia, Suzuki GSX R) claimed Race 2 of Round 4 of the 2019 Motul Pirelli Australian Superbike Championship in an intense battle with second-placed rival Troy Herfoss (Penrite Honda Racing, Honda CBR 1000 SP). Race 1 winner Mike Jones (Desmosport Ducati, Ducati Panagale FE) staged an outstanding comeback to recover to finish third after dropping back to 14th, enough to help him leapfrog Cru Halliday (Yamaha Racing Team, Yamaha YZF R1) and Bryan Staring (Kawasaki BCperformance, Kawasaki ZX10RR) into the championship lead.

RACE 1

Polesitter Jones got the jump off the line to lead them into Turn 1, with Herfoss slotting himself into second spot and Maxwell finding himself bundled back to fifth. Turn 8 saw Herfoss blast past Jones to take the lead early and briefly lead the race before the Ducati displayed its grunt to retake the lead as the field began lap two.

Daniel Falzon (Yamaha Racing Team, Yamaha YZF R1) was starting to apply some pressure to teammate Halliday as the field settled into a rhythm but lost the front end on the way through Turn 6 and crashed out of the race. At the head of the field, Jones and Herfoss were followed by Halliday, Maxwell, Staring and Josh Waters (Team Suzuki ECSTAR Australia, Suzuki GSX R).



Maxwell was pestering Halliday for third position and got the move done down the front straight on lap seven to claim third, taking Herfoss for second soon after with Halliday following through to send Herfoss back to third. By the halfway mark, Jones was more than a second up on Maxwell, Halliday, Herfoss, and

Staring, with Waters now beginning to lose touch with the lead group. As has been the trend throughout the 2019 season, Staring was beginning to pick up the pace towards the second half of the race and was now looking for a way past Herfoss.

Staring made the move out of Turn 12 on lap 11, up into fifth position. Jones was still at the head of the field, but the gap over the pursuing trio of Maxwell, Halliday and Staring was closing up as they upped the pace over the closing three laps. With two to go, Staring was pushing to overtake Halliday for the final podium spot when he lost the front end into Turn 4, with the Kawasaki rider resuming to finish 12th. Jones crossed the line 2.1 seconds ahead of Maxwell, who managed to hold off a hard-charging Halliday in third ahead of Herfoss and Waters. Maxima BMW's injury replacement Aaron Morris (BMW \$1000R) rode like a series regular to finish sixth.

RACE 2

Jones once again had the holeshot for Race 2 but this time it was Daniel Falzon (Yamaha Racing Team, Yamaha YZF R1) who was in hot pursuit. But before Jones could get comfortable in the lead, he ran wide in the grass at Turn 6, and his dreams of a clean sweep at his home race were in tatters. Herfoss worked up into the lead before Maxwell decided that he might like to lead for a while, passing Herfoss at Turn 5. After 2 laps it was Maxwell, Herfoss, Falzon, Halliday, and Josh Waters (Team Suzuki ECSTAR Australia, Suzuki GSX R) in the top five, with Staring a tenth further back.

Lap five and Aaron Morris' (Maxima BMW, BMW S1000RR) race was over at Turn 2, picking up his bike out of the grass. At the front, Maxwell and Herfoss were at the head of the field, having stretched out almost a second's worth of lead from Halliday. Jones had resumed 14th, and in a stunning ride made his way up to seventh.

Halfway through and Jones was pestering Staring for fifth position, on his way back up the field after his disastrous opening lap. Staring and Jones passed Waters on lap 11 to promote themselves up the leaderboard and send Waters back to sixth.

With four laps to go a queue was forming behind Halliday in third, with Staring and Jones looking to make their way past. Whilst Staring would make it by Halliday down the main straight, it would be Jones making it past them both, completing his epic

comeback performance to claim third and salvage a spot on the podium.


Wayne Maxwell took the chequered flag ahead of Troy Herfoss, Jones, Staring, Halliday and Waters.

"Amazing, what can I say?" said Maxwell on the podium "Team Suzuki ECSTAR Australia, hats off to them, ever since the start of the year when I joined the team, they've made me feel welcome. It's a team effort, and I can't thank them enough.

"My old mate Troy (Herfoss), I was thinking 'He's not going to let up!', so I stopped looking at my lap board and started looking at his, and then just tried to control the race from there.

"Great reward for the team and I'm looking forward to the next three races on the calendar."






