








# PHILLIP ISLAND GRAND PRIX CURCUIT MAP

# GETTING STARTED: RACING Words: Jeff Ware

# **OUT OF PIT LANE**

As you sit here and wish you could be out there on the track, don't forget that getting started in motorcycle racing isn't as hard as you think.

Chances are you already own a bike that can be raced. These days there are classes for just about anything with two wheels, regardless of age or performance level.



# **NI NIOL**

The most important step is to get started and get involved!

Motorcycling Australia's (MA) is the sanctioning body for all motorcycle racing in Australia. All National Licences are handled by each State's or Territories respective State Controlling Body (SCB). Step one is contacting your relevant SCB and the joining a motorcycle club in your local area. Next, you obtain a Junior (7-U16 years) or Senior (16 years and over) National Licence, which is managed through your SCB.

Further information can be found via the MA website, www. ma.org.au/getting-started.

Don't be afraid to check out numerous clubs in your local area before joining one. Each club is unique and finding the one that suits you best will make the transition to road racing that bit easier!



# **GETTING LICENCED**

Each club and your SCB will be more than happy to guide you through the licencing process. Depending on your age, will dictate which national licence you obtain.

# **PROTECTION**

While we don't like talking about it, people do fall off motorbikes on racetracks. MA requires all licence holders to have their own personal Ambulance subscription. We'd recommend that you have your own income protection and that it includes coverage for motorcycle racing. No one wants to use up all of their sickies and holidays recovering from an accident.



Protection also includes your own riding gear. Starting from the top, you require a full-face helmet that is approved to AS1698, which is the Australian Standard for helmets for street use anyway. Alternatively, MA also recognises international standards so if your helmet does not have AS1698 you can check with MA that it is ok to use.

A set of one-piece leathers that fit is the preferred way to cover the larger parts of your anatomy. Make sure they're roomy enough for you to wear the mandatory back protector underneath, and a chest protector is recommended too.

The best leather gloves you can afford will keep your digits intact if you're sliding down the track and using your hands

There's a huge variety of suitable boots on display at any decent-sized motorcycle shop. Take the time to find a pair that fit properly without being too tight. Tight boots will ruin your day very quickly.

# **GETTING YOUR BIKE READY**

If you're not overly mechanically minded, don't worry, your local bike shop should be able to check your bike over before you venture on track for the first time. A full service and tune-up now could save you from a big bill later. All racing classes have common rules to ensure bikes don't fall apart or leak fluid on the track. Before you're allowed on track at any race meeting, your bike will be inspected by a scrutineer. Don't give them a hard time if they pull you up and point out something you've forgotten.

The majority of them have been doing this for a long time and don't want to see anybody get hurt due to an oversight. Full rules for your class are in the Manual of Motorcycle Sport available at www.ma.org.au. But keep in mind that bike preparation is very important and quite in-depth for racing. Like you, your bike needs controlled fluid retention.

# TIPS FOR KEEPING COMFORTABLE

Assuming you're like the rest of us, you'll be carting yourself and your bike to the track in a trailer, ute or van. There are a few things we'd advise you chuck in. These may sound obvious but people still forget.

Grab an esky and fill it with ice bricks and bottles of cold water. You'll be amazed at just how easy it is to dehydrate while racing on a hot day.

Even though racetrack food has improved from the days of dodgy hamburgers and warm soft drinks, chuck snack-type things in the esky along with sandwiches. You'll burn off a lot of calories in a day and replacing them with racetrack food could send you broke.

Not all racetracks offer covered pit areas so some sort of shade device will make your day much more enjoyable. Don't forget the sunscreen either.

The most important thing to take with you is a sense of humour. On its own this could be the difference between a day best forgotten and one of the best experiences of your life.

If you think you can't afford to race think again. It costs the same to race as it does to maintain a road bike or a track day bike, and entry fees for club racing are around that of a ride day – but you get a lot more laps at many race meetings...

# **GET YOUR GEAR ON**

You need the best you can afford and then some more. Spend more on your gear than your bike if you have to but, like is the case with your bike, having shiny new parts is a waste if you are learning. You will inevitably test your riding gear. A lot. So go for an affordable compromise. Don't buy the most expensive graphics on your lid if a plain white one is going to be cheaper, for example. But don't skimp on quality...

# YMF R3 CUP & BLU CRU OCEANIA JUNIOR CUP

Two Championships that are a great starting point for younger and beginner racers is the Yamaha Motor Finance (YMF) R3 Cup and the bLU cRU Oceania Junior Cup.



The YMF R3 cup is a spec-racing series for riders commencing their national road racing journey. All the YMF R3 Cup riders use the same bike model, the Yamaha YZF-R3, which produces an even playing field that fosters and encourages new riding talent. The race-ready R3 Cup bike is a great way to get started and is also eligible to race in the YMI Supersport 300 category when the rider is ready.

The bLU cRU Oceania Junior Cup, a new Junior Road Race Academy for competitors aged 11 to under 16 years, is another fantastic avenue through which aspiring junior riders can commence their racing career.

For the single price of \$7,750 AUD (2019 price and excluding travel and accommodation), juniors can apply to join the ground-breaking program which can set them on a path on a Road to MotoGPTM. Every rider in the bLU cRU Oceania Junior Cup is equipped with a Yamaha YZF-R15, delivering a dependable and reliable ride on an even playing field.

Providing an invaluable experience in pursuing a career in Road Racing, the bLU cRU Oceania Junior Cup is an immensely important step in the right direction as Australian juniors embark on their road to success!

# THE BIKE

You'll need to spend a bit of time here – all fluid retaining fasteners need to be lockwired, fairings need catch areas in the bellypan, you need a tether kill switch, brake callipers bolts need to be lockwired and you need good suspension, brakes and bodywork. You also need a bullet-proof engine because you are going to thrash it beyond any ride day or road level of thrash!

# RACE 1

2013 Australian Superbike Champion, Wayne Maxwell (Team Suzuki Ecstar Australia) took his 38th Superbike career win when he edged out DesmoSport Ducati's Mike Jones by 1.861 seconds to win race one of the Kawasaki Superbike Championship.



Jones, who lead the championship by two points heading into the opening 16-lap race and Maxwell bolted away from the rest of the pack in the first handful of laps, before the duo got into their own little private duel that saw them dicing for the top spot around the 3.0km circuit on numerous times.

On lap nine, Maxwell ran wide while holding down second, however it was only a matter of laps before the 36-year-old Victorian carved the gap and made his way by Jones yet again. In the end, Maxwell was able to earn a superb victory over Jones, while Penrite Honda Racing's Troy Herfoss was third, 3.991 seconds behind Jones.

Herfoss, who could only manage a twelfth place in qualifying, which was his worst qualifying position in his ASBK Superbike career put on a master class performance to slice his way through the field to finish in third place.

Cru Halliday (Yamaha Racing Team) was fourth, which saw him slipping ten points behind Jones in the title fight, while Maxwell's teammate, Josh Waters was fifth

Daniel Falzon (Yamaha Racing Team), who started his 65th Australian Superbike race came home in sixth ahead of Bryan Staring (Kawasaki BCperformance), Matt Walters (Kawasaki Connection), Alex Phillis (Team Suzuki Ecstar Australia) and Arthur Sissis (Suzuki).

# RACE 2

The second race was simply an action-packed race, which this time saw Jones claiming the race win by just .048 seconds over Maxwell.

Race two was abridged to ten laps after two restarts due incidents at turn two. The first claiming Mark Chiodo (Penrite Honda Racing) in a shocking high-side that also involved Kawasaki BCperformance's Kyle Buckley. When the race got restarted again, it was Falzon and Lachlan Epis who also hit the deck at the second corner.

The second restart, which was acknowledged as a wet race, saw Maxwell and Jones taking command of the race. While the race was declared wet, all of the riders were racing on slick tyres.

While Maxwell and Jones were dicing for the lead, Herfoss was carving his way through the field like a hot knife through butter. On the opening lap, Herfoss, who was starting his 76th race start in the premier category, made his way from twelfth to fourth place. By lap two, the 32-year-old found his way up into third, moving past Staring. On lap five however the rain started to come down, which saw Jones and Maxwell sticking their hands up wanting the race to be stopped. While this happening, Herfoss rode straight past the pair moving into the lead of the race.

The second race was stopped there and then with the results going back a lap, which meant Jones was the overall victor ahead of Maxwell with Herfoss in third.


Staring ended up 3.183 seconds behind Herfoss in fourth, while Waters was fifth again. Sissis, Aaron Morris (Maxima BMW), Damon Rees (Honda), Halliday, who ran wide on the opening laps and returned to the track at the back of field, and Walters who completed the top ten.



Overall, Maxwell took the round win, his 17th round in the Superbike class, scoring 35-points, 1.5-points ahead of Jones, while Herfoss was third overall, his 22nd overall Superbike podium from a total of 35 rounds started.

Waters was fourth, his 37th top five overall finish out of 45 round starts, while Halliday was fifth, scoring 23-points for the round.





After making its debut in 2016, the YMF R3 Cup returns for it's opening round at Wakefield Park, New South Wales (NSW). 
