








SYDNEY MOTORSPORT PARK CURCUIT MAP

GETTING STARTED: RACING Words: Jeff Ware

OUT OF PIT LANE

As you sit here and wish you could be out there on the track, don't forget that getting started in motorcycle racing isn't as hard as you think.

Chances are you already own a bike that can be raced. These days there are classes for just about anything with two wheels, regardless of age or performance level.

The most important step is to get started and get involved!

Motorcycling Australia's (MA) is the sanctioning body for all motorcycle racing in Australia. All National Licences are handled by each State's or Territories respective State Controlling Body (SCB). Step one is contacting your relevant SCB and the joining a motorcycle club in your local area. Next, you obtain a Junior (7-U16 years) or Senior (16 years and over) National Licence, which is managed through your SCB.

Further information can be found via the MA website, www. ma.org.au/getting-started.

Don't be afraid to check out numerous clubs in your local area before joining one. Each club is unique and finding the one that suits you best will make the transition to road racing that bit easier!



GETTING LICENCED

Each club and your SCB will be more than happy to guide you through the licencing process. Depending on your age, will dictate which national licence you obtain.

For further information, contact your club or your SCB.

PROTECTION

While we don't like talking about it, people do fall off motorbikes on racetracks. MA requires all licence holders to have their own personal Ambulance subscription. We'd recommend that you have your own income protection and that it includes coverage for motorcycle racing. No one wants to use up all of their sickies and holidays recovering from an accident.



Protection also includes your own riding gear. Starting from the top, you require a full-face helmet that is approved to AS1698, which is the Australian Standard for helmets for street use anyway. Alternatively, MA also recognises international standards so if your helmet does not have AS1698 you can check with MA that it is ok to use.

A set of one-piece leathers that fit is the preferred way to cover the larger parts of your anatomy. Make sure they're roomy enough for you to wear the mandatory back protector underneath, and a chest protector is recommended too.

The best leather gloves you can afford will keep your digits intact if you're sliding down the track and using your hands

There's a huge variety of suitable boots on display at any decent-sized motorcycle shop. Take the time to find a pair that fit properly without being too tight. Tight boots will ruin your day very quickly.

GETTING YOUR BIKE READY

If you're not overly mechanically minded, don't worry, your local bike shop should be able to check your bike over before you venture on track for the first time. A full service and tune-up now could save you from a big bill later. All racing classes have common rules to ensure bikes don't fall apart or leak fluid on the track. Before you're allowed on track at any race meeting, your bike will be inspected by a scrutineer. Don't give them a hard time if they pull you up and point out something you've forgotten.

The majority of them have been doing this for a long time and don't want to see anybody get hurt due to an oversight. Full rules for your class are in the Manual of Motorcycle Sport available at www.ma.org.au. But keep in mind that bike preparation is very important and quite in-depth for racing. Like you, your bike needs controlled fluid retention.

TIPS FOR KEEPING COMFORTABLE

Assuming you're like the rest of us, you'll be carting yourself and your bike to the track in a trailer, ute or van. There are a few things we'd advise you chuck in. These may sound obvious but people still forget.

Grab an esky and fill it with ice bricks and bottles of cold water. You'll be amazed at just how easy it is to dehydrate while racing on a hot day.

Even though racetrack food has improved from the days of dodgy hamburgers and warm soft drinks, chuck snack-type things in the esky along with sandwiches. You'll burn off a lot of calories in a day and replacing them with racetrack food could send you broke.

Not all racetracks offer covered pit areas so some sort of shade device will make your day much more enjoyable. Don't forget the sunscreen either.

The most important thing to take with you is a sense of humour. On its own this could be the difference between a day best forgotten and one of the best experiences of your life.

If you think you can't afford to race think again. It costs the same to race as it does to maintain a road bike or a track day bike, and entry fees for club racing are around that of a ride day – but you get a lot more laps at many race meetings...

GET YOUR GEAR ON

You need the best you can afford and then some more. Spend more on your gear than your bike if you have to but, like is the case with your bike, having shiny new parts is a waste if you are learning. You will inevitably test your riding gear. A lot. So go for an affordable compromise. Don't buy the most expensive graphics on your lid if a plain white one is going to be cheaper, for example. But don't skimp on quality...

YMF R3 CUP & BLU CRU OCEANIA JUNIOR CUP

Two Championships that are a great starting point for younger and beginner racers is the Yamaha Motor Finance (YMF) R3 Cup and the bLU cRU Oceania Junior Cup.



The YMF R3 cup is a spec-racing series for riders commencing their national road racing journey. All the YMF R3 Cup riders use the same bike model, the Yamaha YZF-R3, which produces an even playing field that fosters and encourages new riding talent. The race-ready R3 Cup bike is a great way to get started and is also eligible to race in the YMI Supersport 300 category when the rider is ready.

The bLU cRU Oceania Junior Cup, a new Junior Road Race Academy for competitors aged 11 to under 16 years, is another fantastic avenue through which aspiring junior riders can commence their racing career.

For the single price of \$7,750 AUD (2019 price and excluding travel and accommodation), juniors can apply to join the ground-breaking program which can set them on a path on a Road to MotoGPTM. Every rider in the bLU cRU Oceania Junior Cup is equipped with a Yamaha YZF-R15, delivering a dependable and reliable ride on an even playing field.

Providing an invaluable experience in pursuing a career in Road Racing, the bLU cRU Oceania Junior Cup is an immensely important step in the right direction as Australian juniors embark on their road to success!

THE BIKE

You'll need to spend a bit of time here – all fluid retaining fasteners need to be lockwired, fairings need catch areas in the bellypan, you need a tether kill switch, brake callipers bolts need to be lockwired and you need good suspension, brakes and bodywork. You also need a bullet-proof engine because you are going to thrash it beyond any ride day or road level of thrash!

ROUND 6 SUPERBIKE REVIEW

GET UP TO SPEED WITH ALL THE ACTION FROM ROUND 6 OF THE ASBK

RACE 1

Wayne Maxwell confirmed his 2019 championship credentials with a runaway race victory from second on the grid, in the opening race for Round 6 of the Motul Pirelli Australian Superbike Championship at Phillip Island.



The high-speed circuit was made even more challenging than usual due to gusty conditions, but a confident Maxwell powered around the outside of Mike Jones to take the lead into Southern Loop on the opening lap. The Suzuki rider took advantage of clear track to disappear into the distance, leading every lap. Maxwell's final winning margin was only 1.6 seconds, but in reality it was a dominant performance in which he was never seriously challenged.

Jones, who had set a new lap record in qualifying, was left to battle with impressive privateer Kawasaki rider Matt Walters and Honda competitor Troy Herfoss for second place.

Herfoss' bike came on strongly in the second half of the race, and he relentlessly attacked Jones, finally making the decisive move for second heading into Turn 10 on the final lap. While Walters fought gallantly, his challenge faded towards the end of the race, and he lost positions to Josh Waters (Suzuki) as well as the Yamahas of Cru Halliday and Daniel Falzon.

For Halliday, fifth place provided a solid bundle of points for the title contender, after a patchy performance in practice and qualifying where he struggled for outright pace compared to some of his key rivals.

Bryan Staring (Kawasaki), Mark Chiodo (Honda) and Glenn Allerton (BMW) completed the top 10.

RACE 2

While Wayne Maxwell may have dominated Race 1, the second of the Phillip Island races provided an enthralling spectacle which had serious implications for many of the key championship players.

Jones and his Desmosport Ducati team had improved their package after Race 1, and it was clear from the race start that he was going to provide much more threatening competition to Maxwell than in the opening race.

While the two riders battled for the lead, the Yamaha duo of Daniel Falzon and Cru Halliday had both made good starts, and were running in third and



fourth positions after the opening lap. However, Halliday's title hopes were dealt a bitter blow on the second lap, when he crashed out at Turn 10.


Jones and Maxwell continued their battle for the first six laps, but chaos erupted on lap seven when the two riders made contact on the exit of Turn 4, causing Jones to tumble into retirement.

Taking advantage of the drama was Troy Herfoss, whose Honda again came on more strongly as the race progressed. After a thrilling last-lap duel in which the two riders repeatedly swapped places, it was ultimately Herfoss who prevailed by just 0.28s at the finish.



Josh Waters finished third ahead of Daniel Falzon; Matt Walters completed his impressive weekend with fifth place on his Kawasaki, while Glenn Allerton (BMW), Damon Rees (Honda), Alex Phillis (Suzuki), Lachlan Epis (Kawasaki) and Sloan Frost (Suzuki) completed the top 10.





The 2020 OJC Calendar will see the young competitors contesting two international rounds alongside the Superbike World Championship and MotoGP and four rounds alongside ASBK.




