The Australian Superbike Championship (ASBK) will have Sporting Regulations in which are a combination of sporting, technical and judicial rules specific to ASBK.

The Competitor Information Kit will supplement the ASBK Sporting Regulations and to provide competitors with all the additional information they require for the season for Rounds 1 - 7.

Competitors for all classes in ASBK (including support classes) are required to read this document and complete the required information as requested.

The Australian F1 and F2 Championship and Oceania Junior Cup have specific Supplementary Regulations related to their Series, which competitors must also read in conjunction and prior to competition.

#### 2.4 Non-Acceptable Methods

Messages sent via SMS/text, Facebook messenger, Instagram messenger or any other social media platform regarding ASBK matter will not be accepted. Please put your request in writing via email or phone the relevant contact listed in this document.

# 3. General Information

#### 3.1 New Competitors

Competitors who have not previously competed in ASBK are required to email through supporting evidence of their experience in road racing. Ie: race results to <u>roadrace@ma.org.au</u>. The ASBK Event Management Team will then review your submission.

#### 3.2 Guardians

All competitors under the age of 18 must be accompanied by their parent. If a parent is not attending the event, they are required to complete the Nomination of Guardian Form and return it to Motorcycling Australia prior to the commencement of the event. Competitors without a nominated Guardian Form or parent present will not be eligible to ride.





### 3.3 Rider Numbers

- **3.3.1** Competitors must apply for a Rider Number by completing the ASBK Rider Number Application within this Information Kit. Existing allocations are available on the Competitor Info Section of ASBK.com.au
- **3.3.2** It is compulsory for competitors to run their registered number at all ASBK Events
- 3.3.3 Numbers are available for sale at all ASBK rounds from the Race Secretary
- 3.3.4 Stylised numbers are subject to approval. Email design to roadrace@ma.org.au

#### 3.4 Decals

MA receives the right to stipulate that various stickers/decals are to be affixed to machines according to Championship sponsorship requirements.

#### 3.5 On Board Cameras

No on board camera are allowed without prior approval. On board camera application forms can be obtained from the Race Office. Your applications form is to be taken to technical inspection with your motorcycle with camera mounted. Technical inspection will then approve or decline the applications.

No Helmet camera are allowed.

The rights to the video from onboard cameras belong's to Motorcycling Australia and cannot be used without written permission from Motorcycling Australia.

#### 3.6 Web Links

This document and the <u>Competitor Info Page</u> on <u>www.asbk.com.au</u> are the best places to find all the information that is available for ASBK. Information is posted and communicated as soon as it becomes available. If the information you are seeking is not yet posted, then it is probably not yet available.

How to Enter an Event on Ridernet is a step-by-step guide for those new to the Ridernet system.

Tyre Homologation List is a list of approved tyres for the Championship. This will be release on 8<sup>th</sup> February 2021 and may change throughout the year. Any updates to the Homologation List will be communicated to all competitors.

#### 3.7 Media Grids

**3.7.1** For all Superbike and Supersport races there will have a media grid will take place for all, refer to the ASBK Sporting Regulations 3.6 – Pre-Race Media Grids for further information.

Media Grids for selected Supersport 300 races throughout the 2021 season may occur. Races where these media grids will occur will be advised via the ASBK updates and Final Instruction of the round, where applicable.

**3.7.2** Any equipment containing oil, water or fuel must <u>not</u> contaminate the track with fluids whilst being used. The only fluids allowed on the grid are drinks for riders which must be in a split proof container.

Re-fuelling of motorcycles is not allowed and no additional lubricants other than that which are contained within the motorcycle are permitted on the track, this includes but is not limited to chain lubricants, brake fluid, engine oil or Non Glycol radiator coolant.





### 3.8 Withdrawals – Refund Policy

For the withdrawal of an entry to be valid it must be made in writing at least 10 working days prior to the first day of the round in question. A withdrawal under these criteria will receive a refund however, \$20 of the entry fee will be withheld for administrative costs and all credit card and processing fees will not be refunded.

If you are withdrawing within 10 working days of the first day of a round, this needs to be completed in writing and accompanied by a medical certificate. A refund will be granted once this is received and \$20 of the entry fee will be withheld for administrative costs and all credit card and processing fees will not be refunded.

#### **3.9 Ridernet Profiles**

It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure their Ridernet profile is up to date and accurate. It is advised to add your bikes including VIN and Engine Number at the start of the year, this information is then stored in your profile and can be applied to each event. Competitors without a VIN and/or Engine Number on their entry may result in delays/refusal from Technical Inspection.

### 3.10 International Competitors

International Competitors are eligible to compete in ASBK, please refer to the Round Location details for IMNs. To obtain a Ridernet ID tied to your FIM Licence contact <u>roadrace@ma.org.au</u>. Refer to Section 6.2 Licensing for details.

### 3.11 Trade Alley

International competitors require an FIM Licence (including New Zealand), issued by their respective FMN, and must furnish both a Start Permission and an FIM Licence for all ASBK Rounds. The FIM Licences that will be accepted for The Event are Annual International Circuit Racing Meetings Licence and One Meeting International Circuit Racing Meetings directly linked to the IMN for the Round. International competitors will require a valid start permission issued by their respective FMN.

#### 7.2 Timing

#### 7.2.1 Transponder Rental

One timing transponder is allocated per rider with their entry fee, if you require an additional timing transponder please ensure you include this on your entry via Ridernet in the products section. Additional transponders are an additional cost of \$15. An additional transmitter may not be available unless indicated on the entry. If transmitters are available, the cost for ordering on-site is \$25.00.

A valid credit card number (which can be retained for the series) must be provided prior to collecting the transponder for security deposit purposes. Competitors will be responsible for all costs to repair or replace a transponders supplied to them by Computine. The cost of a replacement transponders is \$600.

#### 7.2.2 Transponder Bracket

Transponder mounting brackets are not provided with the rental transponder. Riders may purchase brackets from Computine when collecting transponders at a cost of \$12 to be paid by EFT at the **Event**.

Further information in regards to transponders and credit card security deposits will be provided in the Final Instructions.

# 7.3.1 Tickets

Tickets are required from Friday morning, some events may differ with confirmation advised via the Final Instructions. Competitors found to not have their tickets at the gate will be required to purchase new tickets. Children 15 and under are free.

# 7.3.2 Car Park Passes

Competitors and vehicles found to be in violation of the car parking restrictions are subject to fines and further penalties.

### 7.3.2.1 P1 (Paddock) Access

Competitors in Superbike, Supersport, Supersport 300, and YMF R3 Cup will receive one P1 Car Park Sticker per round for a working vehicle only, which grants access to the paddock. The sticker must be affixed to the windscreen of the working vehicle/side of the trailer and list the competitor's name and phone number. Rental and personal cars will not be eligible to park in the paddock even with a P1 Car Park Sticker, these vehicles will be re-directed to P2 Parking. Cross entries will receive 1 car park sticker irrespective of number of classes entered.

# Working Vehicle is defined as the main vehicle or trailer the rider or team are using to work from.

# 7.3.2.2 P2 Parking

Competitors in Superbike, Supersport, Supersport 300 and YMF R3 Cup will receive one P2 Car Park Sticker per round for a second vehicle, which grants access to P2 Parking Only. The sticker must be affixed to the windscreen of the vehicle and list the owners name and phone number. Cross entries will receive 1 car park sticker irrespective of number of classes entered.

# 7.3.3 Entry Closing Dates

Entries must be received by MA before 11:59pm on the dates listed in the "Closing Date" table below.

Late entries, which will be considered at the discretion of ASBK Event Management, will incur a late fee of \$150.00, competitors will not be listed in the event program and preferred garage allocation will not be available.

# 8. Sponsor Decals

The class sponsor decals and MA sticker must be the only stickers/decals placed above the number-plate on the screen or bodywork of the machine.

Machines not displaying the required decals will not be permitted onto the track or if found to have gone on track without the required decals, may be black flagged during the session or race. The penalty for not carrying the ASBK and class sponsor decals or MA sticker in the required position on the machine is loss of qualifying time or exclusion from the results of a race.

# 9. Garage signage

All competitors are required to affix their name and class to the front of their garage/carport/marquee at each round. Refer to ASBK Sporting Regulations 1.28.5.

# 10. Points Scoring

# 10.1 Points Scoring

In the event of a race being cancelled in its entirety, no points will be awarded although the race will have deemed to be run in regard to the overall Championship.

One (1) Pole Point will be awarded to the Superbike, Supersport, Supersport 300, and YMF R3 Cup. Sidecars refer to Supplementary Regulations.
