The Penrite Australian Superbike Championship presented by Pirelli (ASBK) will have ASBK Sporting Regulations in which are a combination of sporting, technical and judicial rules specific to ASBK.

The Competitor Information Kit will supplement the ASBK Sporting Regulations and to provide competitors with all the additional information they require for the season for Rounds 1 – 5.

Competitors for all classes in ASBK (including support classes) are required to read this document and complete the required information as requested.

Oceania Junior Cup have specific Supplementary Regulations related to their Series, which competitors must also read in conjunction and prior to competition.

3. General Information

3.1 New Competitors

Competitors who have not previously competed in ASBK are required to email through supporting evidence of their experience in road racing. ie: race results to track@ma.org.au. The ASBK Event Management Team will then review your submission.

3.2 Guardians

All competitors under the age of 18 must be accompanied by their parent. If a parent is not attending the event, then a nominated Guardian must be present. A parent of an under aged competitor must inform the Race Secretary racesec1@ma.org.au or MA Event Manager – track@ma.org.au of the guardian's name and contact details prior to the event on the following form [GUARDIAN FORM](#) also available on the Competitor Info Section of ASBK.com.au

3.3 Rider Numbers

3.4 Decals

MA reserves the right to stipulate that various stickers/decals are to be affixed to machines according to Championship sponsorship requirements.

3.5 On Board Cameras

No on-board camera is allowed without prior approval. On board camera application forms can be obtained from the Race Office. Your application form is to be taken to technical inspection with your motorcycle with camera mounted. Technical inspection will then approve or decline the applications.

No helmet cameras are allowed including cameras that are inserted into the helmet or attached in any way, unless the camera is integrated into the helmet by design of the manufacturer.

The rights to the video from onboard cameras belong to ASBK and cannot be used without written permission from ASBK Management Team.

3.6 Web Links

This document and the [Competitor Info Page](#) on www.asbk.com.au are the best places to find all the information that is available for ASBK. Information is posted and communicated as soon as it becomes available. If the information you are seeking is not yet posted, then it is probably not yet available.

Tyre Homologation List is a list of approved tyres for the Championship. This will be released on 10th February 2026 and may change throughout the year. Any updates to the Homologation List will be communicated to all competitors.

3.7 Media Grids

3.7.1 For all Superbike and Supersport races there will have a media grid will take place for all, refer to the ASBK Sporting Regulations.

3.7.2 Any equipment containing oil, water or fuel must **not** contaminate the track with fluids whilst being used. The only fluids allowed on the grid are drinks for riders which must be in a split proof container.

Re-fuelling of motorcycles is not allowed and no additional lubricants other than that which are contained within the motorcycle are permitted on the track, this includes but is not limited to chain lubricants, brake fluid, engine oil or Non Glycol radiator coolant.

3.8 Withdrawals – Refund Policy

For the withdrawal of an entry to be valid it must be made in writing at least 10 working days prior to the first day of the round in question. A withdrawal under these criteria will receive a refund however, \$50 of the entry fee will be withheld for administrative costs and all credit card and processing fees will not be refunded.

If you are withdrawing within 10 working days of the first day of a round, this needs to be completed in writing and accompanied by a medical certificate. A refund will be granted once this is received and \$50 of the entry fee will be withheld for administrative costs and all credit card and processing fees will not be refunded.

3.9 Ridernet Profiles

It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure their Ridernet profile is up to date and accurate. It is advised to add your bikes including VIN and Engine Number at the start of the year, this information is then stored in your profile and can be applied to each event. Competitors without a VIN and/or Engine Number on their entry may result in delays/refusal from Technical Inspection.

5.2 Licencing

International competitors require an FIM Licence (including New Zealand), issued by their respective Federation (FMN), and must furnish both a Start Permission and an FIM Licence for all ASBK Rounds they wish to compete in. The FIM Licences that will be accepted for The Event are Annual International Circuit Racing Meetings Licence and One Meeting International Circuit Racing Meetings directly linked to the IMN/NMFP for the Round. International competitors will require a valid start permission issued by their respective FMN.

** All competitor and/or teams who request a garage upgrade (ie: from ½ to a Full garage) MUST complete payment PRIOR to on-track activity.

6.2 Timing

6.2.1 Transponder Rental

One timing transponder is allocated per rider with their entry fee, if you require an additional timing transponder, please ensure you include this on your entry via Ridernet in the products section. Additional transponders are an additional cost of \$20. An additional transmitter may not be available unless indicated on the entry. If transmitters are available, the cost for ordering on-site is \$25.00.

Competitors will be responsible for all costs to repair or replace a transponder supplied to them by Computime. The cost of a replacement transponders is \$600.

6.2.2 Transponder Bracket

Transponder mounting brackets are not provided with the rental transponder. Riders may purchase brackets from Computime when collecting transponders at a cost of \$15 to be paid by EFT at the Event.

Further information regarding transponders and credit card security deposits will be provided in the Final Instructions.

6.3 Tickets and Car Park Passes

6.3.1 **Tickets** are required from Friday morning; some events may differ with confirmation advised via the Final Instructions. Competitors found to not have their tickets at the gate will be required to purchase new tickets. Children 12 and under are free.

Transit (T) Access

Competitors and teams are advised that from 2025 onwards, there will be NO car passes issued for entry into the paddock area. If you require access into the paddock area, limited passes will be available to be signed out at the Race Secretaries office at the event. These will be transit passes, and not for parking. Once the pass is issued, you must return it to the Race Secretaries office within 2 hours. This pass must be affixed to the windscreen at all times.

*TBC Round 1. Competitors and vehicles found to be in violation of the car parking restrictions are subject to fines and further penalties.

6.3.2.1 P2 Parking

All SBK and SSP competitors will receive two P2 Car Park passes per round, all other categories will receive one P2 Car Park pass per round which grants access to P2 Parking Only. The pass must be displayed in the windscreen of the vehicle. Cross entries will receive 1 car park pass irrespective of number of classes entered. *TBC Round 1

6.4 Entry Closing Dates

Entries must be received by MA before 11:59pm on the dates listed in the "Closing Date" table below.

Late entries, which will be considered at the discretion of ASBK Event Management, will incur a late fee of \$200.00, competitors will not be listed in the event program and preferred garage allocation will not be available.

7. Sponsor Decals

The class sponsor decals and MA sticker must be the only stickers/decals placed above the number-plate on the screen or bodywork of the machine.

Machines not displaying the required decals will not be permitted onto the track or if found to have gone on track without the required decals, may be black flagged during the session or race. The penalty for not carrying the ASBK and class sponsor decals or MA sticker in the required position on the machine is loss of qualifying time or exclusion from the results of a race.

8. Garage / Pit Box signage

All competitors are required to affix their name and class to the front of their garage/pit box/carport at each round. Refer to ASBK Sporting Regulations.

9. Points Scoring

9.1 Points Scoring

In the event of a race being cancelled in its entirety, no points will be awarded although the race will have deemed to be run regarding the overall Championship.

One (1) Pole Point will be awarded to the Superbike, Supersport, Next Gen, Supersport 300 and Oceania Junior Cup.

9.2 ASBK Teams Championships for Superbike and Supersport/Next Gen

Series trophies will be awarded to the leading teams in both the Superbike class, and a combined Supersport/Next Gen class. Each team is required to register with ASBK Operations at time of entry.

Points scoring for the ASBK Teams Championship is based on the combined points of the top two (2) competitors in each team (Superbike Class and Supersport/Next Gen Class) points accumulated during the course of the season with the team ranked accordingly.

To be eligible for ASBK Teams Championship points a team must hold a valid MA Entrants Licence and be a registered team with ASBK Operations.

There is no limit as to how many riders a team wish to enter in each class, however only the top two point scores in each team will be counted.





